What do we know from the notice?</p> <p>(A) The summer school is three weeks long.</p> <p>(B) Students can order lunch from the school restaurant.</p> <p>(C) There are basketball classes in the gym every week except the third week.</p> <p>(D) Those who need to borrow dancing shoes must tell Mr. Shum the day before.</p>
疑 義 內 容	<p>(B) Students can order lunch from the school restaurant. 由 notice 可知可向班長訂購，再由班長向學校餐廳訂購，所以班長只是 middle man 的角色，學生可向餐廳訂購仍屬事實。</p>
說 明	<p>1. 從 notice 第一條僅能得知學生須在前一天跟班長登記訂購午餐，無法判斷從何處訂購。然由選文中“The school restaurant is closed during the summer school (7/4~7/31).”可知學校餐廳在暑期課程期間沒有營業，推論班長向學校餐廳訂購午餐與選文語意衝突，因此選項(B)非最佳解。</p> <p>2. 本題維持原正答選項(C)。</p>

疑 義 內 容	<p>我認為第 23 題的正確答案(D)並不完全符合題意，因為題目是問「下列選項哪一個是對詩中敘述最正確的說明」，但(D)選項較主觀了些，原因如下：</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 詩中並沒提到 speaker 有自己一個人在家(being by himself)</li> <li>2. 詩中從頭到尾沒有寫出”ghost”一詞，若只以”And pulling me down to their house under the ground.”去判斷那就是鬼，似乎太主觀。</li> </ol> <p>因上述原因，我覺得選項(C)相較起來更符合題意，因為較客觀。原因:1.詩中的 1、2 段倒數 1、2 句明顯地看出 speaker in the reading 在家中(kitchen, balcony)找尋他的 toy puppy 和 candy.</p>	
說 明	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 選項(C)意思為 Tommy 想要尋找<u>他遺留在家裡某處</u>的東西，然從詩中描述只知 Tommy 想去廚房拿糖果吃和拿在陽台上的娃娃，無法判斷他先前是否把糖果留在廚房或把娃娃放在陽台，故選項(C)的敘述無法從選文內容判斷。</li> <li>2. 從詩的第一、二段的描述—狂風大起、房門嘎嘎響、黑暗的廚房及很高的陽台都暗示主角 Tommy 很害怕，且從文中的詩句“Will you be with me, my dear Lucy,”、“Wish you could always be with me...”、“So please stay with me...”可推知他不要一個人，想要有 Lucy 的陪伴。</li> <li>3. 詩中雖無直接使用“ghost”一詞，但三、四段運用“Halloween”、“And pulling me down to their house under the ground.”及大風颳得門一直嘎嘎作響的情境來營造詩中的“they”要把 Tommy 帶去他們在地下的房子。從這些語句判斷 Tommy 口中的“they”為鬼，為合理的推論，非沒有根據的主觀認定。</li> <li>4. 以上三點線索皆與選項(D)「他感覺身邊有鬼時害怕一個人」描述相符合，沒有衝突，選項(D)為本題最佳解。</li> <li>5. 本題維持原正答選項(D)。</li> </ol>

疑 義 內 容	<p>本文敘述 soldier 的想要退出職場而求助 hospital 的例子而要考生選擇可能的“example”(C)答中是想要得到 job 的比喻，使得考生困惑，應不能選為答。</p>
說 明	<p>1. 本題組漫畫第 10 格提到“Now people use “catch-22,” the name of Joseph Heller’s book, to mean that <b><u>someone has a problem like the soldier’s.</u></b>”意指現人們已把 catch-22 一詞用來泛稱漫畫中飛官所陷困境的相似矛盾情形，並非僅僅指想要退出職場的情形。第 27 題題幹敘述亦是問哪一個選項的例子是 catch-22 的例子。本題四個選項中僅有選項(C)的描述最符合「要完成甲事前須先完成乙事，但不完成甲事又無法完成乙事」的矛盾情境，為本題的最佳解。</p> <p>2. 本題維持原正答選項(C)。</p>

疑義內容	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 該題題目已明確提到 Alec 希望邀約的人是 Olivia，所以要完善這個計劃來迎合 Olivia，而 Lori 所說“若要依照這個計劃，你只能和她約會一次”意指 Alec 計畫無法迎合 Olivia 喜好，代表 Lori 也覺得 Alec 不了解 Olivia，故答案應為(B)。</li> <li>2. 由文章內容可知 Olivia 並不喜歡昆蟲與海鮮，但 Alec 並不同意，可知 Alec 並不了解 Olivia。文中 Lori 說 If you follow this plan, I'm sure it'll be your only date with her. 可知 Lori 認為 Alec 的安排並不妥當。且 Emily 為 Olivia 的女性朋友，不太可能建議他 change a girl，而較可能跟她說你並不了解 Olivia。</li> <li>3. (C) or have a date with a different girl，Lori 並未提及此，且 Emily is a friend of Olivia's，應不希望其失戀，此句意看不出是否為威脅用語。(B)代表 Alec 根本不了解 Olivia，與 Lori 所說相符。請逐項回答。</li> <li>4. (B)、(C)有爭議。(B)你永遠不懂像 Olivia 這種女生想要、喜歡什麼？／(C)你應該換一個計劃或換一個女生約會。因為 Alec 不了解 Olivia 到底喜歡什麼或討厭什麼，所以才會擬出這種計畫，Lori 不認為這計劃可以追到 Olivia，所以題目，如果我是 Emily，可以說(1)你根本不了解 Olivia 這種女生，因為的確是因為 Alec 不了解 Olivia，(B)只是用了更重的口氣；也可以說(2)你該換計畫或是對象，故我認為(B)、(C)都可以</li> </ol>


說明

1. 本題要求選出與 Lori 立場相同的選項，因此必須從 Lori 的談話來判斷。本篇選文中 Lori 的兩句話 “I thought you wanted her to be your girlfriend.” 與 “If you follow this plan, I’m sure it’ll be your only date with her.” 主要表達 Lori 覺得 Alec 的約會計畫不適合 Olivia，非暗示 Olivia 的喜好難以捉摸或 Alec 永遠不會知道 Olivia 的喜好(Alec 在與 Ellie 的對話即已知 Olivia 對於昆蟲的厭惡)。
2. 選項(B) “You never know what a girl like Olivia would want.” 意思為「像 Olivia 這樣的女生喜好很難捉摸／你永遠不會知道像 Olivia 這樣的女生的喜好(字面的意思)」。從選文中 Ellie 的談話可清楚知道 Olivia 的喜惡，且 Lori 的談話也無此暗示。
3. 選項(C) “Make a different plan or have a date with a different girl!”非 Lori 所提，而是與 Lori 立場相近的話。從 Lori 文中的兩句話與第 31 題題幹的敘述無法判斷 Emily 是否不希望 Olivia 失戀或有意威脅 Alec，不適合以此為據來排除選項。
4. 選項(C) “Make a different plan or have a date with a different girl!”意指若 Alec 不改變這個不適合 Olivia 的約會計畫，就乾脆和別的女生約會。此一立場與 Lori 說 “If you follow this plan, I’m sure it’ll be your only date with her.” 來暗示這個約會計畫不適合 Olivia 的立場最相近，為本題最佳解。
5. 本題維持原正答選項(C)。

疑義內容	<p>1. (C) would want, 為 will want 的過去式, 如為委婉用法也合理, 合語譯[意]。為什麼不能選?</p> <p>2. (A) had wanted 是否表示過去某時段 Molly 希望她女兒繼承, 此刻則否? 且過去完成式不能單獨存在, 需與另依過去式子句「連」用, 後一句表示她女兒的習慣, 並無直接關聯。(C) Molly 會希望她女兒接應對, 且雖然將此店關閉, 不代表 Molly 不希望她女兒接此店。請逐項回答 (若堅持 A++ 只能錯一題, A+ 只能錯三題, 不僅增加壓力, 也代表不容粗心, 出題應謹慎或標準放寬。請重視此問題)</p>			

說明

1. 疑義者所提 would 可做委婉口氣用，然本文以 Molly 為主角，以第三人稱陳述烘焙店的過去，並非與他人對話，不適合使用委婉語氣表達禮貌或客氣的態度。此外，would want 做為 will want 的過去式，即表示 would 意在表達過去中的未來時態。從選文第一段可知 Molly 已將烘焙店賣給他人(A young man had bought it)，於此使用 would want 表達 Molly 之後可能會想把烘焙店傳給她女兒的語意與第一段語意有衝突，非本題最佳解。
2. 本篇選文描述的時間點在過去。本題前句“it would all come to an end tonight.”的時間點為故事敘述的當下(過去式)，下一句要描述在此時間點之前的事件，宜用過去完成式，避免時間序混亂，因此本題應選(A) had wanted，表達 Molly 是在決定把店賣掉前希望她女兒繼承。
3. “But her daughter was never interested in baking.”一句非表示 Molly 女兒的習慣，而是表達事實。選文第一段明白表示烘焙店已經賣給他人，已無讓女兒繼承的選擇，選項(C)would want 表達 Molly 會希望她女兒繼承烘焙店與語意不合。
4. 如疑義者所提，過去完成式不能單獨存在，需與過去式子句連用，然兩者不需要在同一個句子，只要上下文清楚標示時間點即可。
5. A++或 A+只能錯幾題與試題內容無關，不在此回答，請待本次會考正式切點題數公布。
6. 本題維持原正答選項(A)。

試題內容	<p>What does the word <i>family</i> mean to you? An American study in 2006 showed that people today <u>39</u>. Over 99% of the people who were interviewed agree that a husband, a wife, and a child are a family. At the same time, 94% see a parent with a child as a family, 91% say a husband and a wife, without children, are a family, and 81% think a man and a woman, with a child, but not married, are a family too.</p> <p>The study also found that <u>40</u> is very important in the modern thinking on family. Though 81% think a man and a woman, not married, with a child, are a family, the percentage (%) drops to 40% if the couple doesn't have a child. This is also true with same-sex couples. About 60% see two men, or two women, with a child, as a family, but only 32% think so when the couple doesn't have a child.</p> <p>In the study, those who see two men or two women that live together as a family often find it OK for same-sex couples to get married. <u>41</u>. 疑義內容	<p>1. 文中下一句表示並非所有人都能接受同性伴侶，且現實社會中許多國家因法律、宗教等因素並不允許同性婚姻，故我認為(B)This is not possible everywhere.更貼近現實狀況。</p> <p>2. (B)中的 not everywhere 也可解釋為 study 中不是每一處，故此報告中提及有人認同，有人不認同同性婚姻。且(A)中 not surprising: 不出人意外的，在前後文中未提及，且 this is not surprising 是否代表對有人認同不可表示驚訝。英文科標準答案若定太嚴，出題應嚴謹。</p>			

說明	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. 本篇為文意克漏字題組，考題評量語意承接。考量選項時不僅須衡量與上文文意的連貫，也需要考慮下文文意的延續。選項(B)This is not possible everywhere.雖與上句“those who see two men or two women that live together as a family often find it OK for same-sex couples to get married.”的文意看似連貫，但與下句 However, not everyone opens their arms to same-sex couples 有語意衝突(this is not possible everywhere 與 not everyone opens their arms to same-sex couples 表達的立場相當，不應用 however 當轉折詞)。此四個選項中，僅選項(A) this is not surprising.不與下文語意衝突。</li><li>2. 選項(A) this is not surprising.表達前句所言「認為同居的同性伴侶也可以是一種家庭型態的受訪者大多可以接受同性婚姻。」不讓人意外，下句語意轉折，提出有另一群人不這麼認為。選項(C)並非表示對於有人認同不可表示驚訝。</li><li>3. 本題維持原正答選項(A)。</li></ol>
